8. Prayerful

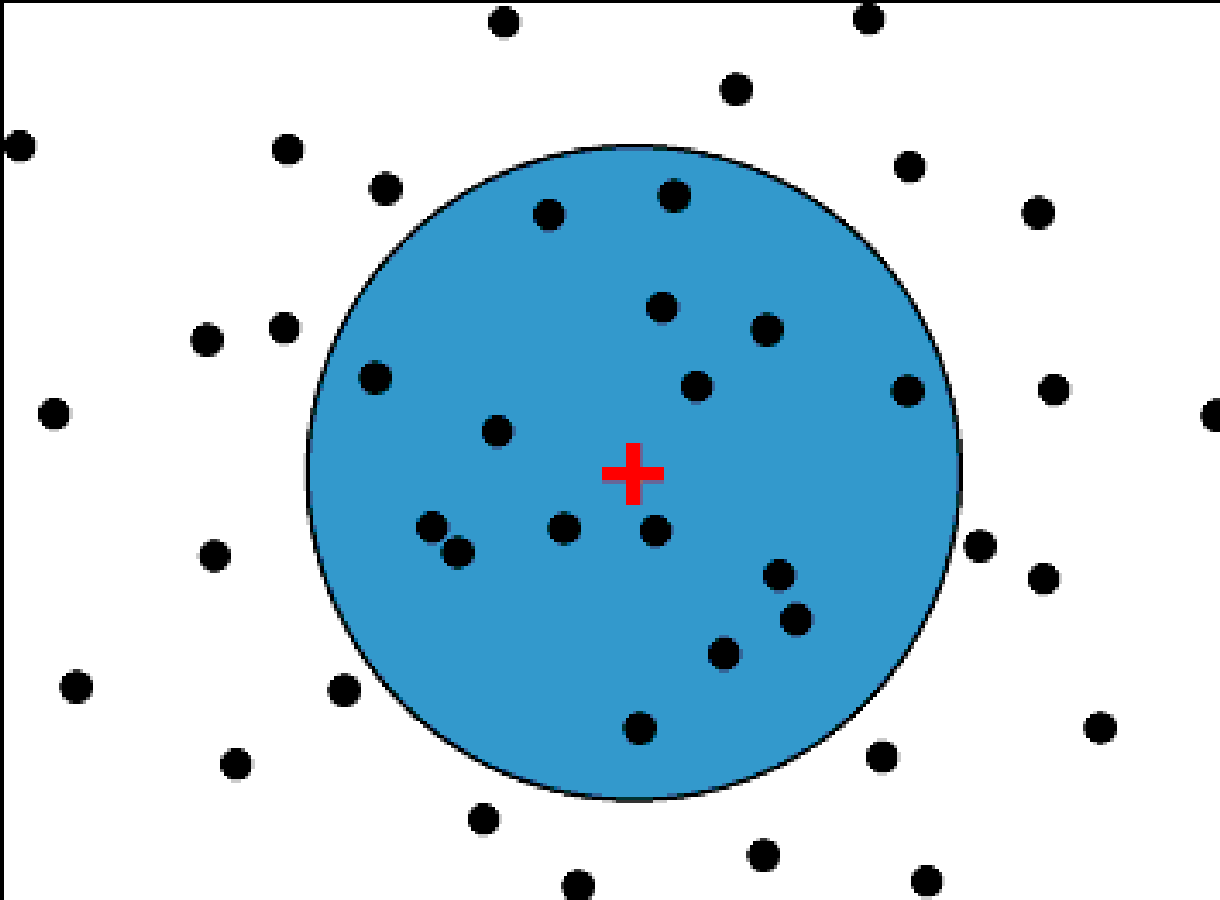
Imagine a church like this!

Centred around Jesus

- ❖ Do we have a big enough picture of Jesus?
- ❖ Is Jesus supreme and Lord in your life?

The closed-set model:

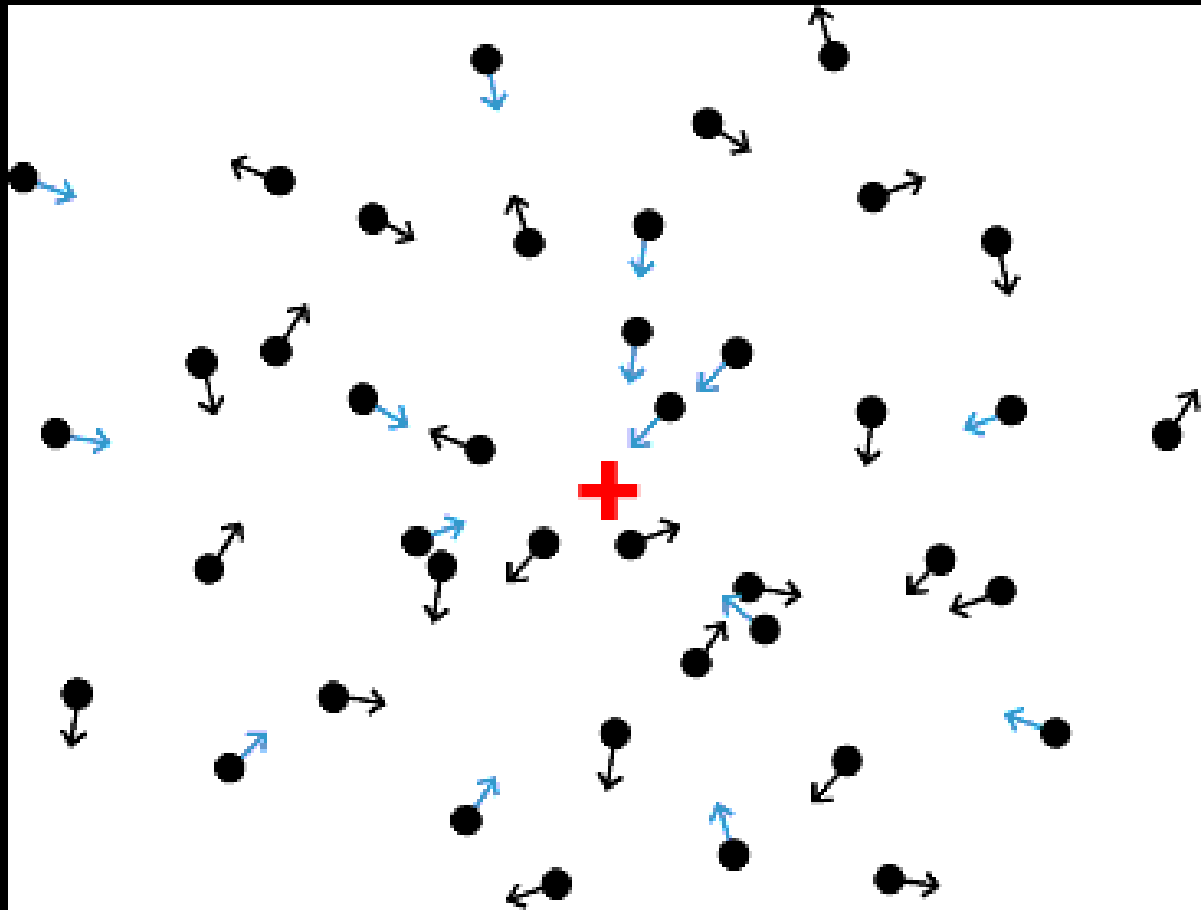
- ❖ A 'closed set' is defined by a boundary –
- ❖ all that is inside belongs to the set,
- ❖ all that is outside does not. (*Blue signifies Kingdom*)



The open-set model:

- ❖ has no 'territorial' boundary,
- ❖ defined by **relationship with a centre**: all that is moving towards the centre, seeking relationship, belongs;
- ❖ all that is moving away, abandoning relationship, does not.

Membership of the Kingdom is defined by movement towards or away from Christ as centre.



Centred around Jesus

- ❖ Faith is a journey towards Christ – “we turn to Christ”
- ❖ Church is a family centred around Jesus – a transformative community
- ❖ The Church is literally his body here on earth – his hands and feet
- ❖ Our aim is to become more like Jesus
 - ❑ spending time with him and those who know him!
 - ❑ Be reading the Bible regularly
 - ❑ see him in the least, the last and the lost –
- ❖ the Christian life is about reflecting Jesus to the world around us – as we become more like Jesus, others notice.
