Forever 2012 is an Olympic outreach project which is a ministry of Youth With A Mission (YWAM). The vision of the project is to impact London before, during and after the Olympics. The project aims to partner with churches and other organisations to work together to make a difference in people's lives. There will be a team in each Olympic city, focusing on Evangelism and Urban ministries, using new ways and fresh ideas to minister to the local community. **Forever 2012** seeks to impart a ministry that will be eternal. I will be working for the Social Justice team, specifically to target the issue of human trafficking in the form of prostitution, which has already begun as a result of the Olympic games.

Sex Trafficking: Facts

- ‘Trafficking’ is modern— day slavery.
- Victims are most commonly women and children.
- Children as young as three are kidnapped and made to work in brothels.
- In some cases, children are sold to traffickers by their own parents to pay for their own alcohol and drug addictions.
- Women and teenagers are often promised work abroad that means they will be able to support themselves and their families. However, when they arrive they are stripped of their passports and told they owe money to the perpetrator and can only pay them back by selling their bodies to up to 40 men per day.
- Victims are beaten and drugged and are fully owned by the criminals.
- 1.2 million children are trafficked every year... that’s 2 every minute.
- \$9.5 billion is made through human trafficking every year.
- 2.3 million people are trafficked every year, and 80% of these are for sexual exploitation.
- Victims suffer repeated abuse: sexual, physical and emotional. Their spirits are broken and their dignity crushed so they succumb to the horror of being bought and sold over and over again.
